Year in Review: Lindgren worked on a longterm case representing Sempra Generation, an affiliate of the San Diego based Sempra Energy, against the California Department of Water Resources. State officials sought to rescind its contract with Sempra Generation, alleging breaches related to the delivery of energy under the contract. But in January 2009, an arbitration panel rejected the

state's claims in all respects.

Next Challenge: Lindgren's work on longterm energy contract disputes will continue. She's also working on a case representing San Diego Gas & Electric, seeking refunds for the purchases of energy from a variety of municipalities.

Most People Don't Know: Lindgren is an avid cyclist. She is the current U.S. record holder for the 20 kilometer Master Women time trial. She's also a volunteer tutor for Schools on Wheels, a group that works with homeless children.
