Although you might expect an announcement of another legal victory, this news is different and to us even more important. Last week the Los Angeles Regional Foodbank announced that Hennigan, Bennett & Dorman LLP won the Platinum Award for contributions made in the Food from the Bar competition. The Food from the Bar campaign invited the legal community in Los Angeles to raise resources for and volunteer at the Los Angeles Regional Foodbank, which assists those facing hunger in Los Angeles County. Nearly 30 prominent law firms in Los Angeles participated--our firm contributed more per employee than any other.

“The Foodbank is pleasantly surprised by the results of this inaugural year of Food from the Bar in Los Angeles, and we congratulate Hennigan, Bennett & Dorman LLP for its tremendous support and well-deserved award,” stated Michael Flood, President/CEO of the Los Angeles Regional Foodbank.

We are especially pleased that the award was not achieved by the firm writing a big check (although that was part of it). Instead, 81% of the contribution made by the firm was raised by the individuals who work here. In addition, we filled two volunteer shifts at the Foodbank facility, adding 147 volunteer hours to the campaign. This dedication and competitiveness reminds us of the efforts our people devote to your cases.

We might leave it at that, but the truth is that the Los Angeles Regional Foodbank needs even more help than we (and the rest of the bar) are capable of giving. The Foodbank reports that local food pantries are experiencing a 31 percent increase in demand, compared to this time a year ago, and a 24 percent increase compared to last November.
